FRANCE—Etape du Tour - amateur day on the Tour de France - is a complete stage over closed roads that includes event support and the memory of a lifetime. Only 8500 people worldwide are allowed this opportunity and normally space sells out months in advance. Discover France now has 20 spaces to offer interested cyclists.

In 2006, a dream ride has been created for Etape - Gap to Alpe d'Huez. The legendary Alpe d'Huez draws tens of thousands of cyclists every year; not to mention hundreds of thousands of fans to watch the stage of the race as it passes the Alpe.

The stage is always offered about a week in advance of the actual pro race and it is over the exact same course. Now cyclists can experience the same thrills and challenges as the pros and comprehend just how superior the racers really are.

From Gap, participants will cover 187 km including the massive unclassified climb of Col d'Izoard, then the Cat 1 Col du Lautaret, and finish on unclassified Alpe d'Huez. This is for only the strongest of amateurs, and while age doesn't matter, fitness does.
